#### Part 6 WRITING TUTOR

##### Useful Vocabulary



- \* Use phrases like:  
*I'm going shopping, I'd like to go shopping, I'd like to buy*
- \* Use vocabulary relating to shopping:  
*a pair of shoes/trainers/trousers, clothes, shop, market, town centre*
- \* Use vocabulary relating to transport:  
*by car, by train, by bus, cycle, ride a bike, walk, on foot*

##### Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Ask John how he is.
- Tell John that you are going shopping on Monday to buy something.
- Ask him to come with you. Say that he can buy something too.
- Tell John how you can get there.

#### SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 31

Hi John,

How are you today? Hope you are feeling better. You said you wanted a pair of trainers. I'm going shopping on Monday. Why don't you come with me? I want to buy a pair of trainers too. I can meet you at the train station at 5 pm if that's OK with you. Let me know.
