Useful Vocabulary

- * Use phrases like:

Why don't we meet at ...? Would you like to meet at ...?
What day is best for you?

Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Tell Alfie that you have some good news / you are moving to his town.
- Explain why you are moving.
- Ask him if he wants to meet you / when he can meet you.

SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 31

Hi Alfie,

I've got some good news. We're moving to your town, on the 2nd of August. You see, my dad's going to work as a teacher in one of the schools there.

Can we meet at the first weekend after the 2nd of August? Let me know.

Useful Vocabulary

- * Use vocabulary relating to preparing for a trip:
choose, clothes, jacket, comfortable, phrase book, language, phrases
- * Use phrases relating to travelling/trips:
go on a trip, go on a tour, tour guide, give information, a group of people/students

Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Give the boy a name. Say why he was preparing his clothes.
- Then say why he was reading the (French) phrase book.
- Say that he went to the coach station, who he met, and what he did there.

SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 32

Paul was trying to choose what clothes he would take with him on his trip. Then he read a book to learn some important phrases in the local language of the country he was going to. Finally, he went to the coach station. There, he met the tour guide and his group. The tour guide gave them some information, and Paul listened carefully.
