

JUST ALREADY YET - PRESENT PERFECT

JUST: Means that something happened a short time ago.
A: Have you bought the tickets for the plane?
B: Yes, I've just bought them. Look! That man has just stolen a lady's purse.

ALREADY: Means something happened earlier than you or someone expected.
A: Don't forget to water the flowers, Jane?
B: Oh, mum. I've already watered them.

YET: Means "until now". It is used at the end of negative sentences or questions.
A: Have you finished your homework yet?
B: No. I haven't finished it yet. I'll finish it soon.
