SPELLING RULES

Translation

To form the -s form we add -s (or -es) to the infinitive.

1. If the verb ends in -ss, -x, -sh, -ch, or -o, we add -es:

pass – passes
fish – fishes
watch – watches
box – boxes
go – goes

2. If the verb ends in a consonant + y, we replace –y with –ies:

cry – cries
carry – carries

3. For all other verbs we just add –s:

play – plays
stop – stops
come – comes
see – sees
