A house is a structure made up of bricks and cement; it is more a physical entity than a home, which connotes emotional feelings. • A home is a place where people live, and they feel they belong to. An apartment is a building full of apartment homes. It is simply the physical structure. Apartment complexes are more than simply homes though. They contain many important rooms and features that are essential to running the complex.



A hotel is an establishment that provides lodging and usually meals, entertainment, and various personal services for the public.





A hut is a small or humble dwelling of simple construction, especially one made of natural materials, as of logs or grass. a simple roofed shelter, often with one or two sides left open



A farm- workplace consisting of farm buildings and cultivated land as a unit; "it takes several people to work the farm" chicken farm- farm where chickens are raised for sale croft- a small farm worked by a crofter dairy, dairy farm- a farm where dairy products are produced farmhouse- house for a farmer and family.



A trailer is a long vehicle without an engine which people use as a home or as an office and which can be pulled behind a car. A large trailer, fitted with parts for connection to utilities, that can be installed on a relatively permanent site and that is used as a residence. Also called manufactured home.



A shelter is a structure, that provides cover or protection, as from the weather: a shelter for hikers. An institution providing temporary housing and sometimes counseling, as for the homeless, runaways, or victims of domestic violence.
