What to wear on top

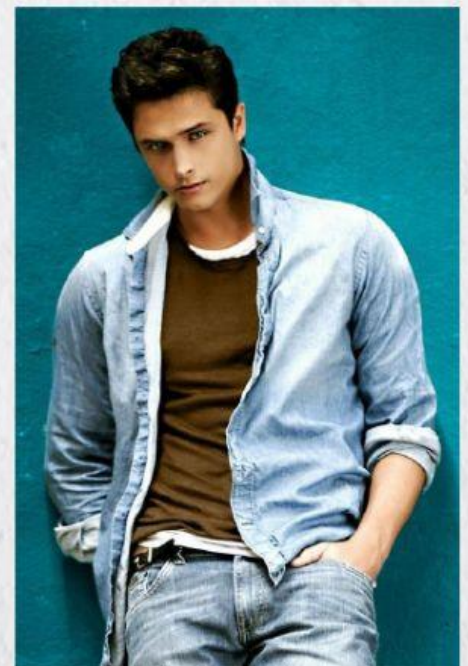
