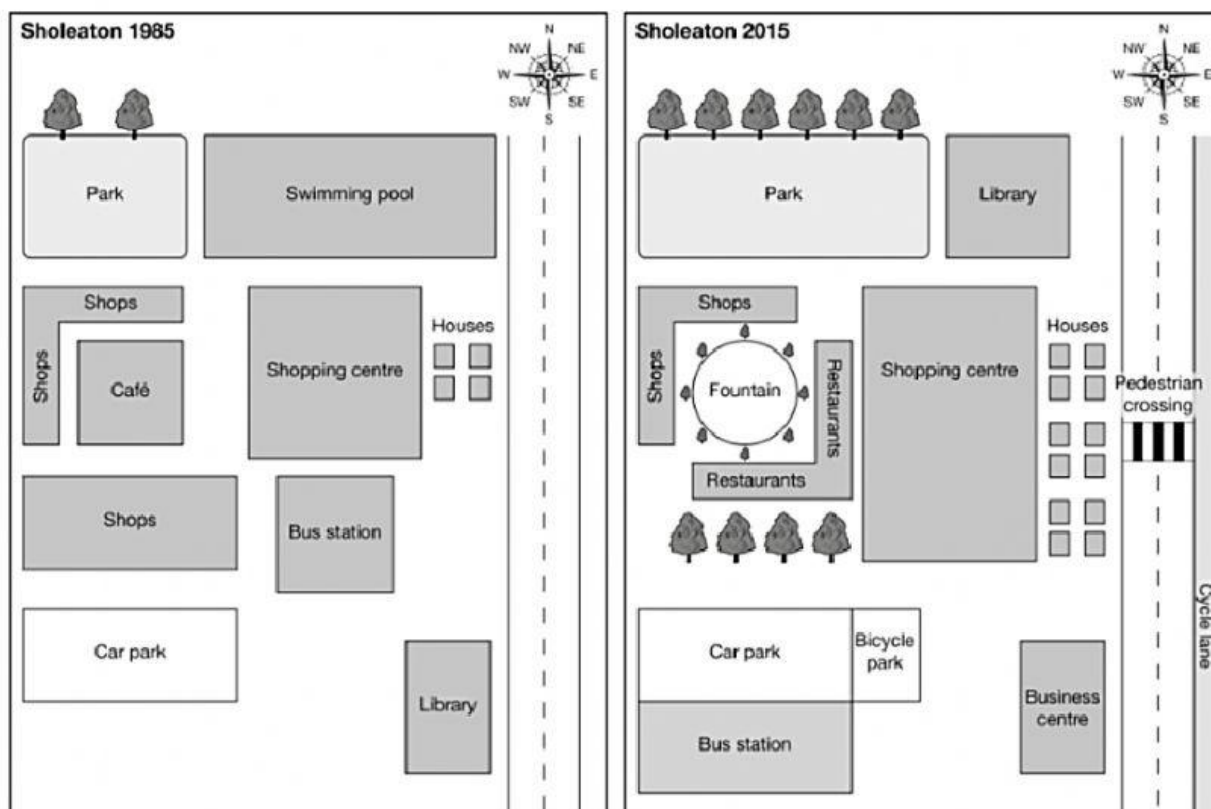

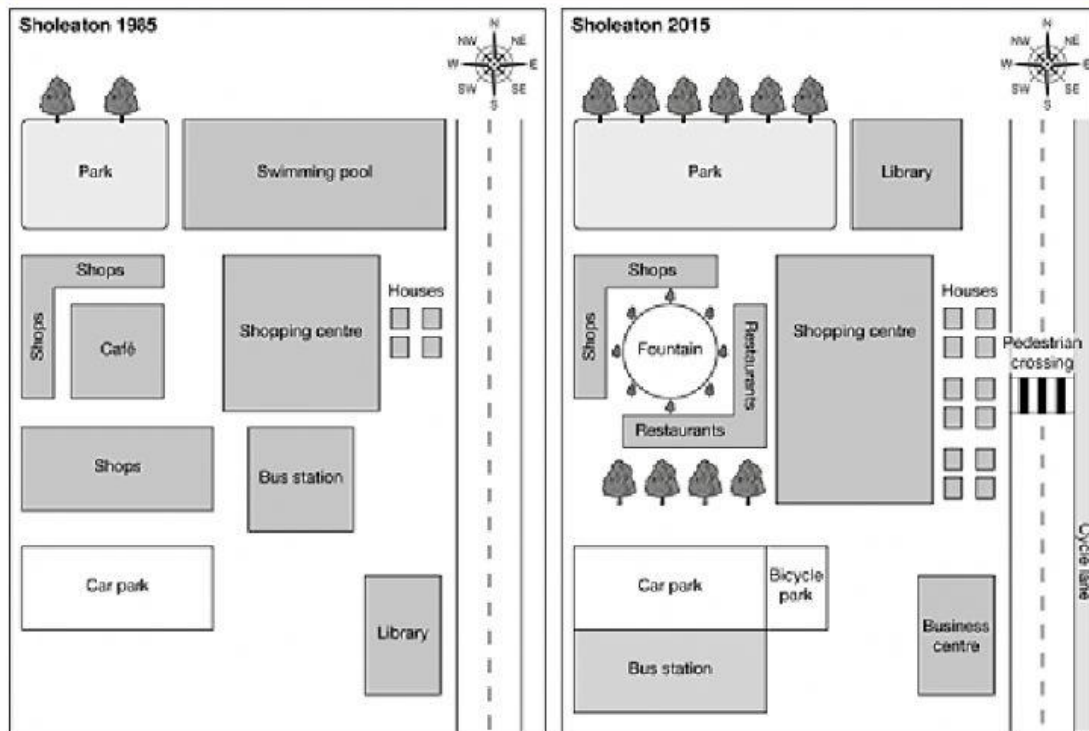
Sholeaton changed quite dramatically in the period shown. Most notably, its swimming pool was demolished to make way for the extension of the park, in addition to the erection of a new library. (Here, cohesive devices – *most notably, in addition to* – are used effectively.)

- 1 ☐ In the beginning, it can be said that many changes took place in Sholeaton between 1985 and 2015.
☐ The maps illustrate how Sholeaton has developed over the period 1985 to 2015.
- 2 ☐ Previously, a swimming pool was located next to the park, but it has been demolished and the green area of the park has been extended.
☐ The most striking feature is that the park was extended and has replaced the swimming pool in the north of the town.
- 3 ☐ A further noticeable feature is the removal of the café to make way for a new fountain in the shopping area in the west of Sholeaton.
☐ Following on from this, the café was converted into a fountain in the shopping area of the town.
- 4 ☐ A further development in this area of the town was the planting of trees around the new fountain.
☐ In the meantime, a few trees were planted around the fountain.
- 5 ☐ On the other hand, in 1985 the shopping centre was small but now it has taken over the bus station.
☐ On the west side of the town, the bus station was replaced by an enlarged shopping centre.
