

2 Three-dimensional objects drawn in orthographic projection with instruments

You should by now have enough confidence to make formal drawings of various views, isometric drawings and orthographic projections.

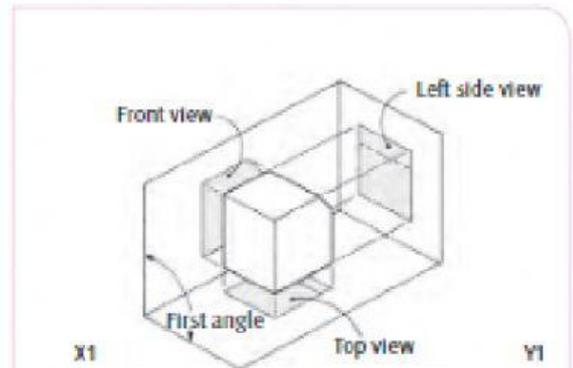


FIGURE 14 A first angle orthographic projection

Activity 4 Isometric drawing




FIGURE 16 Draw different views of this block.

All the arrows are pointing at 90° angles at the different sides of the blocks. Follow the directions of the arrows and use your drawing instruments to draw the following views of the block in **FIGURE 16**:

- 1 the front view as seen from direction A.
- 2 plan or top view, as seen from direction B.
- 3 the side view. Draw it next to the left of the front view and as seen from direction C.
