Instead of traditional punishments, criminals get a punishment that fits their crimes

What other examples of alternative sentencing are there? Two boys were caught writing graffiti on a wall. The normal punishment for this is fine, but in this case, the boys were told to do community service. They cleaned seventy walls in three weeks. A shoplifter was caught shoplifting three times in one year in a small town in the United States. What was her punishment? She was sent to speak to shop owners.
