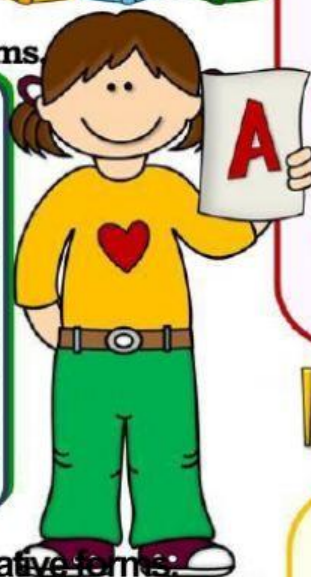


# short adjectives

- one-syllable adjectives take **-er**  
short- short , fast- fast
- one-syllable adjectives ending in -e take **-r**  
nice- nice , late- late
- one-syllable adjectives ending in consonant, vowel, consonant, **double the last consonant** and take **-er**  
fat- fat , hot- hot
- two-syllable adjectives ending in consonant-**y** take **-er** , -y changes to -i  
nasty- nast , easy-eas

modern- modern  
dangerous- dangerous
- with some two-syllable adjectives, we can use **-er** or **more**  
clever- clever / clever  
narrow- narrow / narrow  
simple- simple / simple
