- 1. As the subject of a sentence:
 - "To vote in an election is very important."
- 2. (However, it is more commonly used in IT sentences):
 - "It is very important to vote in an election."
- 3. With TOO and ENOUGH:
 - "This table is too heavy to carry"
- 4. After most common adjectives:

"I'm sorry to see you like this" / "He's determined to find a job"

5. With verbs followed by a (pron)noun + infinitive: advise, allow, ask, beg, cause, challenge, convince, dare, encourage, expect, forbid, force, hire, instruct, invite, need, order, permit, persuade, remind, require, teach, tell, urge, want, warn
