Hang-gliding	A game involving the batting of a hard ball, played by two teams of nine players each on a large field with four bases.
Billiards	A game played on a field by two opposing teams of 11 players each, who try to hit a ball into their opponents' goal using long sticks curved at the end.
Darts	A game in which darts are thrown at a target having a bull's-eye in the center.
Baseball	Any of several games played with hard balls driven with a long, smooth wooden cue into pockets on a cloth-covered table.
Hockey	The sport of launching oneself from a cliff or a steep incline and soaring through the air by means of a hang glider.
