Millions of animals are killed by plastics every year, from birds to fish to other marine organisms. Nearly 700 species, including endangered ones, are known to have been affected by plastics. Nearly every species of seabird eats plastics.

Most of the deaths to animals are caused by being trapped in plastic items or starvation. Seals, whales, turtles, and other animals are strangled by abandoned fishing gear or discarded six-pack rings. Microplastics (very small plastic pieces) have been found in more than 100 aquatic species, including fish, shrimp, and mussels which appear on our dinner plates. In many cases, these tiny bits pass through the digestive system and are expelled without consequence. But plastics have also been found inside the animal bodies, causing death. Their stomachs are packed with plastics so they don't feel like eating and eventually die of hunger.

Plastics have been consumed by land animals, including elephants, zebras, tigers, camels, cattle, and other large mammals, in some cases causing death.

Tests have also shown problems in the reproductive systems of some species such as producing fewer eggs in some kinds of sea animals. This raises new questions about the effects of plastics on fish populations.

Hanoians flocked to the metro line stations over the weekend to experience the first rides on the elevated railway and admire the city from above.

The Cat Linh-Ha Dong metro offered a free ride in its first 15 days of running when passengers were given free tickets to get on the train. At the alighting station, the tickets are collected. Passengers can purchase passes via an automatic ticket vending machine. The machines currently accept cash. In the near future, they will allow transactions via bank cards. The fare of the sky train is US\$1.3/person/ticket/day for unlimited travel. Monthly pass costs from \$4.4 to \$8.8 per person. The elderly, people with disabilities, children under six years old, members of poor households and people with meritorious services such as distinguished war veterans and soldiers can travel for free. Before the Cat Linh-Ha Dong metro was officially put into operation, all the staff had already been thoroughly trained and ready to handle any incident.

Mr. Truong, a passenger, said that his home is near the Cat Linh-Ha Dong metro line and he is thrilled to take the first metro line trip in Hanoi.

To access the 12 train stations of Metro Cat Linh-Ha Dong, passengers can use 55 bus lines that connect with the metro line. The first metro line station is located on Cat Linh Street, Dong Da District and the last one in Yen Nghia Ward, Ha Dong District. The metro line operates from 5:30 am to 10 pm daily. In the first week, trains run at a frequency of 15 minutes. In the second week, the frequency will be 10 minutes.

The operation of the train brings the high hope that residents who live near this route are able to travel to Hanoi's downtown without having to endure rain, pollution, and the frustrating daily traffic jams.
