## Use:

- predictions based on what we SEE or KNOW;
- plans, intentions.

## Form:

be + going to + infinitive verb

am    is    are

I **am going to play tennis this afternoon.**

**Are they going to have a picnic tomorrow?**

**Yes, they are./No, they aren't.**

**Mary is not going to make a party.**
