

## VERB + TO + Infinitive (V. in basic form)

Look at the following examples:

- ⇒ They decided **TO** **move** to another country.
- ⇒ My friends want **TO** **go** to a japanese restaurant.
- ⇒ Their parent would like **TO** **buy** a new car.

Decide, want, plan, hope, would like.
