A. REMEMBER

1. Future simple

*** FORMS**

(+) S + will + V + O.

(-) S + will not + V + O.

(?) Will + S + V + O? -> Yes, S + will.

-> No, S + won't.

will not = won't

*** Examples:** (+) We will play football after school tomorrow.

(-) He won't work next Sunday.

(?) Will Mary play the guitar for an hour next Sunday?

*** TIME EXPRESSIONS**

for future actions which may or may not happen.

- tomorrow
- the day after tomorrow
- next week/month/year.....
- tonight
- soon
- in a week/ month/year.....

2. Conditional type 1

If + S + V(s,es) + O, S + will + V + O.

S + will + V + O + if + S + V(s,es) + O.

*** Examples:**

- If it rains, they will get wet.

- They will get wet if it rains.
