Who's watching?

In the past couple of decades, reality TV shows have become a part of our everyday lives. We are surrounded by them at every step whether we like it or not. Advertised in TV commercials, on magazine covers, large billboards and elsewhere, they are the subject of conversation between children and grown-ups alike. Here are just a few of the most popular shows.

Big Brother was first broadcast in the Netherlands in 1999. It had very high ratings and soon became popular all over the world. The show lasts for about three months. The competitors are isolated from the outside world in a house where their every move is followed by cameras. Each week they have to complete certain tasks. At the end of the week, two competitors are nominated and the viewers decide which one has to leave. The last one to remain in the house wins a cash prize.

In Survivor, contestants are also isolated from the world, yet this time they live on a distant tropical island. They are divided into teams, called 'tribes'. Each 'tribe' gets tools to build a shelter but they have to rely on the island's natural resources for food. During the course of the game, players compete as tribes or individually in contests called challenges. Challenges consist of different tasks that test the players' strength, agility, problem-solving skills, willpower and so on. At the end of each episode one player has to leave. In the end, the player chosen as the Sole Survivor receives a cash prize of \$1,000,000.

The X Factor is a televised music competition created by Simon Cowell. It started in the UK but is now held in various countries. The contestants are ambitious pop singers drawn from public auditions. The "X Factor" of the title refers to a characteristic which is difficult to define but is essential to achieve star quality. The prize for the winning finalist is usually a recording contract. As of October 2012, there have been 73 winners of The X Factor around the world.

Jamie's Kitchen is a British documentary television series which follows celebrity chef Jamie Oliver as he attempts to train a group of fifteen disadvantaged youths. If they complete the course, the contestants are offered jobs at Jamie

Oliver's restaurant Fifteen. The show aired on Channel 4 in 2002. It was a different kind of reality show as it offered young unemployed people a chance to leave their past behind and create a future for themselves.
