

His daily routine

Read about Benjamin's daily routine

Each morning, Ben wakes up at 6 am. Next, he brushes his teeth and takes a shower. He gets dressed quickly. He usually doesn't eat breakfast, but he sometimes gets a coffee on his way to work. Ben is a journalist. He writes on his computer every day.

Ben often has meetings too. He often eats dinner with friends. Before sleeping, he likes to watch TV or read a book. He usually goes to sleep by 10:30 pm.



Now, answer the questions about *you*.

- A. When do you wake up?
- B. Do you usually eat breakfast?
- C. What do you do in the evening?
- D. When do you go to bed?

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Wh- questions and yes/no questions

We use a form of *do* with *Wh*- questions and *yes/no* questions.

For *Wh*- questions in the present simple (for verbs other than *be*):

Wh- word + *do / does* + subject + verb.

He studies **Russian** → **What** does he study?
in the evening at the library.

He studies Russian in the evening → **When** does he study?
at the library.

He studies Russian in the evening at the library. → **Where** does he study?

Remember that we use *do / does* for *yes/no* questions.

He likes his job. > Does he like his job?

We live in London. > Do you live in London?

We add *do / does*, but we don't change the order of

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
