7. Rosa found it very difficult to persuade her boss to give her a pay rise. **GREAT**

Rosa had \_\_\_\_\_ her boss to give her a pay rise.

8. The man claimed that he had been nowhere near the factory at the time of the break-in. **TO**

The man claimed not \_\_\_\_\_ near the factory at the time of the break-in.
