(b) Describe what happened in the Parable of the Great Banquet. [6]

(c) What might Jesus have meant when He said "*Many are called, but few are chosen*"? [3]

(d) Who did the following represent in the parable?  
– The king  
– The servants  
– The invited guest [3]

(e) *"If Jesus did not use parables more people would have understood and accepted His teaching!"*
