NEPTUNE

Neptune is the eighth planet from the Sun. It is difficult to see Neptune – even through a telescope. It is almost three billion miles from Earth.

Scientists believe that Neptune is much like Uranus – made of rock, iron, ice and gases. Neptune has eight moons. Scientists believe that it may also have several rings.

Neptune is so far away from the Sun that it takes 164 Earth years for it to orbit the Sun just once. Scientists still know very little about this cold and distant planet.

- Neptune is the *sixth* / *eighth* planet from the Sun.
- Earth is almost three *million* / *billion* miles from Neptune.
- People know *very little* / *very much* about Neptune.
- Telescopes are used to see Neptune. *Yes* / *No*
