Usamos BE GOING TO + VERBO para hablar de planes futuros.

Ejemplos:

Yo voy a comprar un libro. → I am going to buy a book.

Él va a comer pasta. \rightarrow He is going to eat pasta.

Ellas van a quedar en el parque. > They are going to meet in the park.
