

FUTURE - BE GOING TO

Usamos **BE GOING TO** + **VERBO** para hablar de planes futuros.

Ejemplos:

Yo voy a comprar un libro. → I **am going to buy** a book.

Él va a comer pasta. → He **is going to eat** pasta.

Ellas van a quedar en el parque. → They **are going to meet** in the park.

¡RECUERDA!

El verbo BE puede ser **am** - **is** - **are** dependiendo de cuál sea el sujeto de la frase.

going to: future
(affirmative & negative)

We use *to be* with *going to* and a verb to talk about future plans.

going to: future (affirmative)			
I	'm		catch a bus.
He / She	's	going to	go fishing.
You / We / They	're		wake up early.

going to: future (negative)			
I	'm not		catch a bus.
He / She	isn't	going to	go fishing.
You / We / They	aren't		wake up early.

going to: future
(questions & short answers)

We use *to be* with *going to* and a verb to ask and answer questions about future plans.

going to: future (questions)			
Am	I		catch a bus?
Is	he / she	going to	go fishing?
Are	you / we / they		wake up early?

going to: future (short answers)		
	I	am.
Yes,	he / she	is.
	you / we / they	are.
	I	'm not.
No,	he / she	isn't.
	you / we / they	aren't.



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
