### DOUBLE OBJECT PRONOUNS

BASIC = subj **iop dop conj verb** .....Juan **nos la trae** a Eva y a mí.

OPTION 1 = subj **conj verb inf.+ iop/dop** .....Juan **quiere traérnosla** a Eva y a mí.  
(looks like one word)

OPTION 2 = subj **'estar' -ando, -iendo, (-yendo) + iop/dop**.... Juan **estaba trayéndonosla** a Eva y a mí.  
(looks like one word)

Command = pos. = **command+iop/dop** (Tráenosla. - Bring it to us.)

neg. = No **iop dop command** (No **nos la traigas**. – Don't bring it to us.)

1. Elena wants to bring it to you. (querer + inf) \_\_\_\_\_ (op. 1 / pres)

2. Elena was going to bring them to you. (ir a + inf.) \_\_\_\_\_ (op. 1 / imp)

3. I bring them to you every day. \_\_\_\_\_ (basic / pres)

4. We brought it to Marcos and you. \_\_\_\_\_ (basic / pret)

5. Are you bringing them to Marcos and me? ¿\_\_\_\_\_? (op 2 / pres)
6. Dad was bringing it to the poor. (el dinero) \_\_\_\_\_ (op 2 / imp)
7. Bring them to us! (ud.) \_\_\_\_\_ (com / pos)
8. Don't bring them to me! (tú) \_\_\_\_\_ (com / neg)
