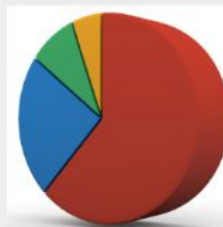
Analyze Graphs



A bar graph is a good choice to **compare data**.

A line graph is a good choice to show **change over time**.
Example: It can be used to show the growth of a tree over 5 years.



A circle graph is a good choice for **comparing parts of a whole**.
Example: to show the different activities of Mr. Gideon's ICT classes.
