

Future Tense (3)

If you are sure what you will do in the future, you can use the words:
Jika anda tidak pasti apa yang anda akan buat/laku dimasa hadapan, anda boleh guna ini:

(i) **Plan to + verb** (means that you will probably do something (bermakna anda akan mungkin membuat sesuatu.))

* I plan to go to eat tonight. (Saya merancang (mungkin) pergi makan malam ini.)

* I don't plan to play tennis tomorrow. (Saya tidak merancang / pasti untuk bermain tennis esok.)

(ii) **Might + verb** (means that you will maybe do something (bermakna anda akan mungkin membuat sesuatu.))

* I might stay home tonight. (Saya mungkin akan duduk/tinggal di rumah malam ini.)

* It might rain tonight. (Kemungkinan ia akan hujan malam ini.)
