"Why did you save my life, Frog?"

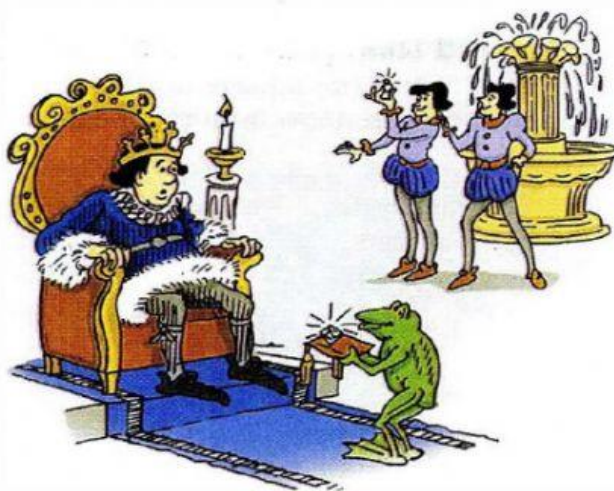
"Because you are very young, and you have a lot to live for."
