**MUST**

90-100% (sure it's TRUE)

- ➔ She **must be** in the garden. (=I'm sure she is in the garden)
- ➔ They **must know** each other.

**CAN'T**

90-100% (sure NOT true)

- ➔ She **can't be** his mother. She's too young. (=I'm sure she is NOT his mother)
- ➔ He's just left. He **can't be** too far.

**MAY/MIGHT (NOT)**

30-50% (maybe it's TRUE)

- ➔ He **may/might be** dead.

30-50% (maybe NOT true)

- ➔ He **may/might not remember** who you are. (=Maybe he does NOT remember)
