

## *Russian fairy tales*


Typical characters of Russian folk tales are Ivan Tsarevich and Vasilisa the Wise.

Often the heroes of Russian fairy tales have assistants.

Russian fairy tales have the ideas of moral values, that you need to be kind and responsive to others ("Morozko").

## *English fairy tales*

The characters of English fairy tales are usually people of different profession: farmers or peasants.

The heroes of some English fairy tales are not always good, they can lie or do something bad ("Molly Whuppie").

Happiness for the hero of an English fairy tale is money, things and so on.


The heroes of many fairy tales are hardworking, independent, honest and brave; some of them become real folk heroes ("Adventures of Jack the Giant-Killer")




