Step #1 - Pre-Write In class you wrote the topic (an important person in my life), the name of the person, and a list of reasons why this person is important.

Step #2 - Outline Use the information from your pre-write to make an outline. An outline helps you organize your ideas and focus your paragraph. You need to write 3 reasons and 3 examples. *For example: Reason - My mother takes care of me. Example - She makes me tea when I'm sick.*
