

## SIMPLE PAST AND PRESENT PERFECT

Ask and answer like in the example:

- A: Have you ever \_\_\_\_\_ (make) tomato soup?
- B: Yes, I have. I \_\_\_\_\_ (make) it yesterday.

- A: Have you ever made tomato soup?
- B: Yes, I have. I made it yesterday.

A: Have you ever \_\_\_\_\_ (eat) scones?

B: Yes, I have. In January, I \_\_\_\_\_ (eat) them at the MPG's open house.

A: Have you ever \_\_\_\_\_ (write) a ghost story?

B: Yes, I have. I \_\_\_\_\_ (write) such a story two years ago.

A: Has Harry ever \_\_\_\_\_ (see) a snake.

Yes, he has. He \_\_\_\_\_ (see) one in Stuttgart's zoo, the Wilhema, some time ago.

A: Has your family \_\_\_\_\_ (be) to Dartmoor?

B: Yes, we have. We \_\_\_\_\_ (be) there last summer.

A: Have you ever \_\_\_\_\_ (find) money?

B: Yes, I have. I \_\_\_\_\_ (find) two Euros last week.

A: Has Lara ever \_\_\_\_\_ (go) to Radford Park?

B: Yes, she has. She \_\_\_\_\_ (go) there a week ago.

A: Has your football team ever \_\_\_\_\_ (win) match?

B: Yes, we have. We \_\_\_\_\_ (win) our first match last Sunday.
