#### Fighting for change

Bibi was a student in Kathmandu in Nepal, forty miles away from her family home when there was an earthquake. 'When I arrived, the community were living in big tents. Everyone was in one place, so there was a lot of noise. People were terrified of the wind and the rain. However, they believed it was better to try to wait patiently for help.'

The earthquake destroyed 500,000 homes and 16,000 schools, and 8,000 people lost their lives. After seeing the damage, brave Bibi wanted to help her country. 'If we didn't move on, we would continue to live in fear. I encouraged my family to build a proper shelter so my brother and father got the wood. Then I realized that it wasn't just my house that was important. I wanted to help my community, too, so I started volunteering.'
