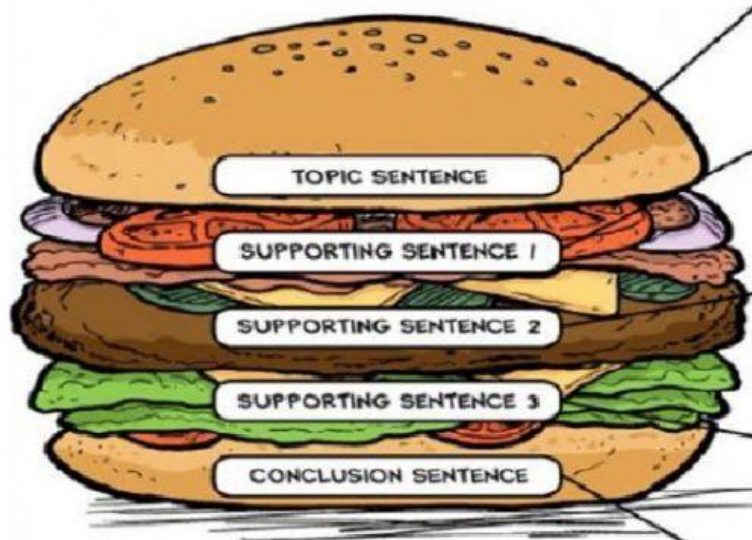
It is celebrated on the 24th of June, and the festivities normally take place at night, and on the beaches.

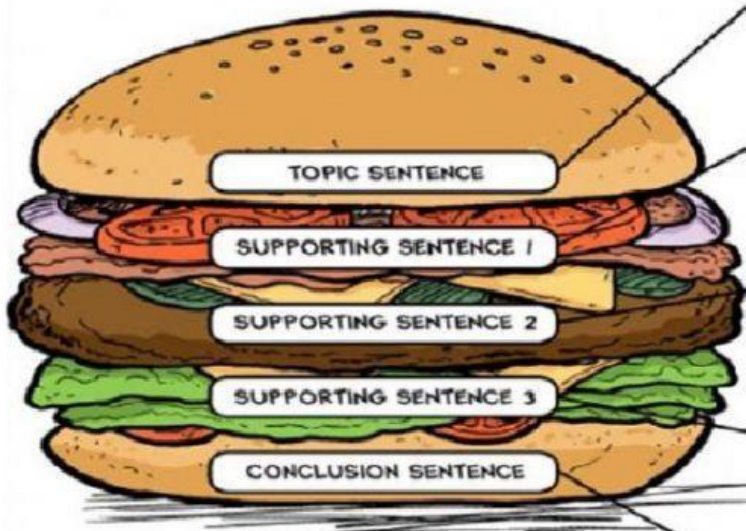
When they are captive, these beautiful creatures become bored and lonely.
