



14-1 Noun Clauses: Introduction

S V O
(a) I know **his address**.
(noun phrase)

S V O
(b) I know **where he lives**.
(noun clause)

Verbs are often followed by objects. The object is usually a noun phrase.*
In (a): **his address** is a noun phrase;
his address is the object of the verb know.

Some verbs can be followed by noun clauses.
In (b): **where he lives** is a noun clause;
where he lives is the object of the verb know.

Động từ thường đi cùng với tân ngữ. Và tân ngữ thường là một cụm danh từ.
*Ở ví dụ (a): **his address** là một cụm danh từ;*
***his address** là tân ngữ của động từ trong câu.*

Một số động từ có thể đi cùng với mệnh đề danh từ.
*Ở ví dụ (b): **where he live** là một mệnh đề danh từ;*
***where he lives** là tân ngữ của động từ trong câu*

S V O
(c) I know **where he lives**

A noun clause has its own subject and verb.
In (c): **he** is the subject of the noun clause;
lives is the verb of the noun clause.
Mệnh đề danh từ có chủ ngữ và động từ riêng.
*Ở ví dụ (c): **he** là chủ ngữ của mệnh đề danh từ.*
***Lives** là động từ của mệnh đề danh từ.*

(d) I know **where my book is**.
(noun clause)

A noun clause can begin with a question word. (See Chart 14-2.)
Mệnh đề danh từ có thể bắt đầu bằng từ để hỏi
(Xem bảng 14-2)


<p>(e) I don't know if Ed is married. (noun clause)</p>	<p>A noun clause can begin with If or whether. (See Chart 14-3.) <i>Mệnh đề danh từ có thể bắt đầu bằng If hoặc whether (Xem bảng 14-3)</i></p>
<p>(f) I know that the world is round. (noun clause)</p>	<p>A noun clause can begin with that. (See Chart 14-4.) <i>Mệnh đề danh từ có thể bắt đầu bằng That (Xem bảng 14-4)</i></p>

14-2 Noun Clauses That Begin with a Question Word

These question words can be used to introduce a noun clause: **when, where, why, how, who, (whom), what, which, whose**.

Information Question	Noun Clause	Notice in the examples: Usual question word order is NOT used in a noun clause.
Where does he live?	(a) I don't know where he lives. S V	<i>Nhìn vào ví dụ có thể thấy: Trật tự từ để hỏi bình thường KHÔNG được sử dụng trong mệnh đề danh từ.</i>
When did they leave?	(b) Do you know when they left? S V	
What did she say?	(c) Please tell me what she said. S V	
Why is Tom absent?	(d) I wonder why Tom is absent. S V	

<p style="text-align: center;">V S Who is that boy? V S Whose pen is this?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">S V (e) Tell me who that boy is. S V (f) Do you know whose pen this is?</p>	<p>A noun or pronoun that follows main verb be in a question comes in front of be in a noun clause, as in (e) and (f). <i>Danh từ và đại từ đứng sau động từ tobe trong câu hỏi thường đứng trước động từ tobe trong mệnh đề danh từ, như ở ví dụ (e) và (f).</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">S V Who is in the office? S V Whose keys are on the counter?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">S V (g) I don't know who is in the office. S V (h) I wonder whose keys are on the counter</p>	<p>A prepositional phrase (e.g., in the office) does not come in front of be in a noun clause, as in (g) and (h). <i>Cụm giới từ (vd: in the office) không được đứng trước động từ tobe trong mệnh đề danh từ, như ở ví dụ (g) và (h).</i></p>
<p>Who came to class? What happened?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">S V (i) I don't know who came to class. S V (j) Tell me what happened</p>	<p>In (i) and (j): Question word order and noun clause word order are the same when the question word is used as a subject. <i>Ở ví dụ (i) và (j): Trật tự từ để hỏi và mệnh đề danh từ giống nhau trong trường hợp từ để hỏi đóng vai trò là chủ ngữ.</i></p>


