Fast and Tall

The giraffe has long, thin legs and is extremely tall, the tallest of all animals. His long neck makes it possible for him to see over the treetops and avoid enemies.

He always looks around carefully before he takes a drink to be sure there are no enemies nearby to pounce on him.

Lions and leopards are his enemies. His greatest defense against enemies is speed. With his long legs he can usually outrun them. When this is impossible, he strikes them with his powerful legs. Sometimes he can even kill a lion with the swift kicks of his hind legs!
