



10-9 Using *Be Used/ Accustomed To* and *Get Used/ Accustomed To* Sử dụng *Be Used/ Accustomed To* và *Get Used/ Accustomed To*

- (a) I ***am used to*** hot weather.
(b) I ***am accustomed to*** hot weather.

- (c) I ***am used to living*** in a hot climate.
(d) I ***am accustomed to living*** in a hot climate.

Examples (a) and (b) have the same meaning: "Living in a hot climate is usual and normal for me. I'm familiar with what it is like to live in a hot climate. Hot weather isn't strange or different to me."

Notice in (c) and (d): ***to*** (a preposition) is followed by the ***-ing*** form of a verb (a gerund).

(e) I just moved from Florida to Alaska. I have never lived in a cold climate before, but I am getting used to (accustomed to) the cold weather here.	In (e): I'm getting used to/accustomed to = something is beginning to seem usual and normal to me. Trong (e): I'm getting used to/accustomed to = cái gì đó đang bắt đầu bình thường đối với tôi.
