0	E	PC	<b>A</b> a computer for use in a single location such as at home or at an office
1		resolution	<b>B</b> a vacuum tube used in older computer monitor
2		screen	<b>C</b> the difference in level between black and white on a computer screen
3		computer	<b>D</b> the sharpness of definition of a display, measured in pixels
4		monitor	<b>E</b> personal computer
5		workstation	<b>F</b> a surface part of a monitor that displays a computer` output
6		aspect ratio	<b>G</b> an electronic device that is used to display computer signals
7		CRT (cathode ray tube)	<b>H</b> an image on a monitor screen
8		desktop computer	<b>I</b> device that person can carry or move it
9		contrast	<b>J</b> it means that computer display has a higher resolution than a standard display
10		notebook	<b>K</b> time it takes ( in milliseconds) for a pixel to go from white (active) to black (inactive) and back again
11		laptop	<b>L</b> the ratio of computer display`s long side to its short side
12		HD (high definition)	<b>M</b> a mobile computer for use in many places
13		personal computer	<b>N</b> a portable computer with a flat touch screen. It is smaller than a laptop but larger than a cellphone
14		display	<b>O</b> a powerful computer for processing difficult tasks
15		portable	<b>P</b> a computer for individual use
16		LCD (liquid crystal display)	<b>Q</b> a measure or description of how fast a computer can complete instructions
17		power	<b>R</b> a small computer that can be carried and used in many locations
18		tablet	<b>S</b> a display that uses liquid crystals to show outputs on a computer screen
19		response time	<b>T</b> a central computer that provides services or stores data for many other computers
20		server	<b>U</b> an electronic instrument for storing and operating on data
