| Affirmative                                 | Negative (not = n't)                                    | Question  |
|---|---|---|
| I <b>should look after</b> the countryside. | You <b>shouldn't throw</b> rubbish on the ground.       | <b>Should</b> he <b>help</b> his mum in the garden? |
| She <b>should tidy up</b> her room.         | We <b>shouldn't forget</b> that we only have one world. | <b>Should</b> they <b>drive</b> a big car?          |
