

# [ʒ] and [dʒ]

[ʒ] is a fricative-alveopalatal-voiced sound. (fricative= it produces friction).

Its most common spelling patterns are:

- **si** (in the middle of words): **lesion, vision, illusion, conclusion**
- **su** (in the middle of words) **closure, unusual, casual.**
- **Gi** and **ge** (in the middle or at the end of words) **beige, regime, massage, camouflage.**
- This sound does not occur at the beginning of words.

[dʒ] is an affricative alveopalatal-voiced sound (affricative= stop sound+ fricative sound).

Its most common spelling patterns are:

- **J** : **joke, jaw, Jew, Jewish, major**
- **G**: **giant, gentle, ranger,**
- **Dd** (usually at the end of words): **fudge, budge, wedge**
- **Ge** (at the end of words) **change, page, age, cage.**
- **Di, du**: **soldier, cordial, graduate, educate, education.**
