

Past Simple-Regular Verbs

Spelling Rules:

1. Verbs ending in **-e** take only **-d**

ex: like**e**-like**d**

2. Verbs ending in a **consonant + y**, drop the y and put **-ied**

ex: stud**y**-stud**ied**

BUT verbs ending in a **vowel + y**, only add **-ed**

ex: st**ay**-stay**ed**

3. Verbs ending in one **stressed vowel** between two consonants, **double the last consonant** and add **-ed**

ex: stop-stop**ped**

BUT visit-visit**ed**

4. Verbs ending in one **l**, **double the l** and add **-ed**

ex: travel-travell**ed**, quarrel-quarrell**ed**
