Past Simple-Regular Verbs

Spelling Rules:

1. Verbs ending in -e take only -d

ex: like-liked

2. Verbs ending in a consonant + y, drop the y and put -ied

ex: study-studied

BUT verbs ending in a vowel + y, only add -ed

ex: stay-stayed

3. Verbs ending in one stressed vowel between two consonants, double the last consonant and add -ed

ex: stop-stopped

BUT visit-visited

4. Verbs ending in one 1, double the 1 and add -ed

ex: travel-travelled, quarrel-quarrelled
