NATURAL RESOURCES

- These are materials from Earth that are used to support life and meet people's needs
- These include air, water, soil, mineral, fossil fuel, plants and animals



RENEWABLE RESOURCES

resources that are available in infinite quantity and can be regenerated at the same rate or faster as they are being used

NON-RENEWABLE RESOURCES

resources that are limited; cannot be replenished easily or not at all

CONSERVATION OF NATURAL RESOURCES

is the practice of caring for natural resources, using them wisely without wasting them or using them up completely.
