Remember:

He She + verb+S It	I You + infinitive verb We They
Eg: She plays the piano very well.	Eg: You play the piano very well.

EXCEPTION TO THE RULE ↑: When the subject is **he, she** or **it** and the **verb...**

a) ends in **o, x, sh, ch** or **ss**:

GO MIX KISS WASH WATCH	+ES	GO ES MIX ES KISS ES WASH ES WATCH ES
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Eg: He **goes** to the cinema every month.

b) ends in **consonant + y**:

CRY TRY FLY	Y + IES	CR IES TR IES FL IES
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Eg: She **cries** with romance movies. / It **flies** very high
