4. Now, put the cooked beef into a bowl. Put the bowls of meat, cheese, and lettuce on the table. Also, put the plate of taco shells on the table. Put a spoon into each bowl.
5. In order to make a taco, put the meat in a shell first. Then, add some cheese. The hot meat will melt the cheese. Next, put in the tomatoes, onions, and lettuce.
6. Put some taco sauce on the top. Enjoy!
