

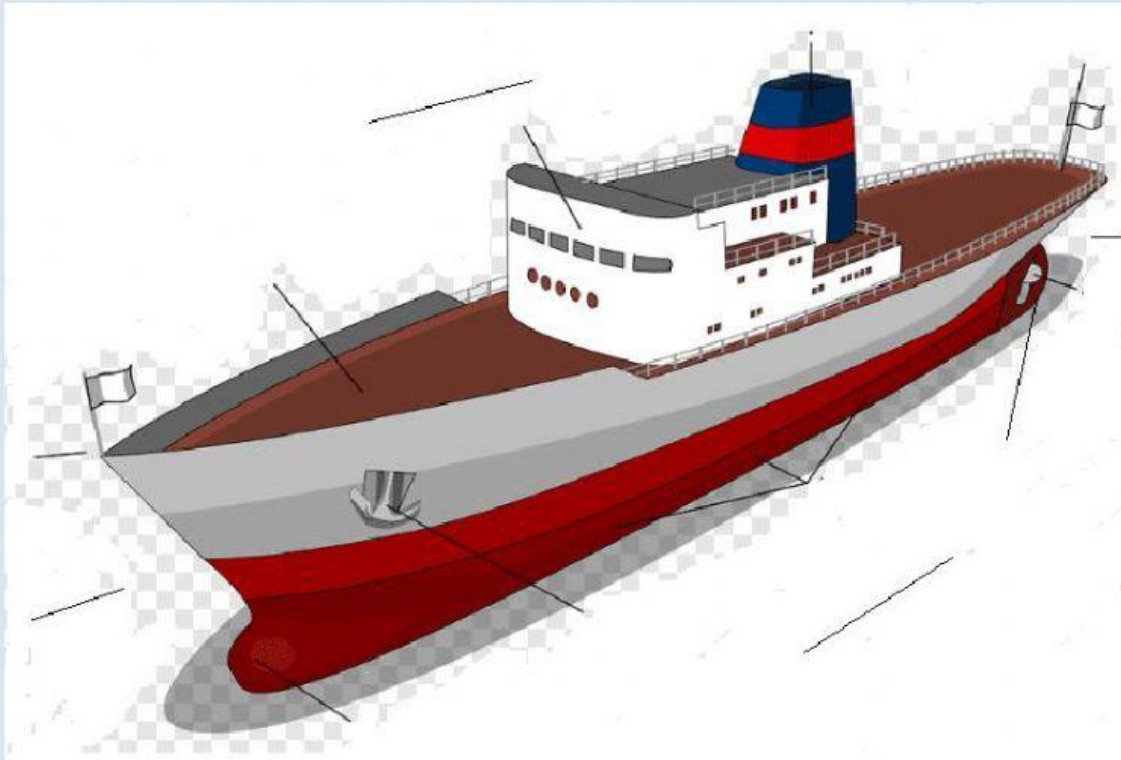
# PARTS OF A SHIP



1) Read the clues and choose the correct name.

1	AFT	In or <b>towards</b> the <b>back</b> of a boat.
2	ANCHOR	A <b>heavy</b> metal object that is <b>dropped</b> into water to stop a boat from moving.
3	BOW	The <b>front</b> part of a ship.
4	BULBOUS BOW	A <b>protruding</b> bulb at the bow (or front) of a ship just below the waterline. The bulb modifies the way the water flows around the hull, reducing drag and thus increasing speed, range, fuel efficiency, and stability.
5	DECK	A flat area for <b>walking</b> on, built across the space between the sides of a boat.
6	FUNNEL	A vertical metal pipe on the top of a ship through which smoke comes out.
7	FWD	The front or <b>in the direction you are facing</b> .
8	HULL	The body or <b>frame</b> of a ship, most of which lies under the water.
9	KEEL	The long piece of wood or metal along the bottom of a boat that forms part of its structure and helps to keep the boat balanced in the water.
10	PORT SIDE	The side of the vessel which is to the <b>left</b> of an observer aboard the vessel and facing the bow, that is, facing forward toward the direction the vehicle is heading.
11	PROPELLER	A piece of equipment that turns around and makes a ship <b>move</b> .
12	RUDDER	A piece of equipment that <b>changes the direction</b> of a boat.
13	STARBOARD	The <b>right</b> side of a ship.
14	STERN	The <b>back</b> part of a ship or boat.
15	SUPERSTRUCTURE	The part <b>above</b> the main deck.
