


PARTS OF A SHIP

| 1 | AFT | In or towards the back of a boat. |
| 2 | ANCHOR | A heavy metal object that is dropped into water to stop a boat from moving. |
| 3 | BOW | The front part of a ship. |
| 4 | BULBOUS BOW | A protruding bulb at the bow (or front) of a ship just below the waterline. The bulb modifies the way the water flows around the hull, reducing drag and thus increasing speed, range, fuel efficiency, and stability. |
| 5 | DECK | A flat area for walking on, built across the space between the sides of a boat. |
| 6 | FUNNEL | A vertical metal pipe on the top of a ship through which smoke comes out. |
| 7 | FWD | The front or in the direction you are facing . |
| 8 | HULL | The body or frame of a ship, most of which lies under the water. |
| 9 | KEEL | The long piece of wood or metal along the bottom of a boat that forms part of its structure and helps to keep the boat balanced in the water. |
| 10 | PORT SIDE | The side of the vessel which is to the left of an observer aboard the vessel and facing the bow, that is, facing forward toward the direction the vehicle is heading. |
| 11 | PROPELLER | A piece of equipment that turns around and makes a ship move . |
| 12 | RUDDER | A piece of equipment that changes the direction of a boat. |
| 13 | STARBOARD | The right side of a ship. |
| 14 | STERN | The back part of a ship or boat. |
| 15 | SUPERSTRUCTURE | The part above the main deck. |
