When a crime is committed the detective is called to the crime scene. He searches it carefully looking for evidence and clues. The witnesses are interviewed and then the detective accuses a man of a crime. Then he puts handcuffs on his hands and takes a suspect to the police station. The suspect is questioned by the police and finally the accused is sent to the court where the judge and jury listen to the accused man, a victim, learn all evidence and clues. A prosecutor accuses the man and the lawyer does all he can to defend the accused man. Finally the judge decides if the accused is guilty or innocent. Depending on the crime the sentence can be different. If a criminal commits a petty crime, the judge can sentence him to fine or community work. If a criminal commits a serious crime he is sentenced to prison.
