Many teenagers are 'gamers' – they have video consoles at home and are mad about playing different games, often for many hours. What effect do these games have on teenagers? For some people, video games have a bad reputation – some believe that they are difficult to stop playing or that playing violent games can encourage violence, but these days many people say that playing video games can also teach teens useful skills that could help them in their life and even in the classroom.

10 Let's start with strategy and role-playing games. In these games, players have to collect information, solve problems, plan, make decisions and negotiate. All of these are very useful skills outside of video games and can help with our schoolwork.

13 What about sports games? Some people say when gamers play sports games, they are more likely to become interested in playing 'real' sports and the games help to teach sports techniques. Playing video games can also help improve hand to eye coordination which is useful in sports!

16 Now, what about the negatives? Some parents worry that video games could make teenagers angry and violent. Video games, like films in the cinema, have a recommended age rating that parents can use so that teens don't play games that have strong violence or bad language.

19 Gamers sit down for a long time when they play, get less exercise and have more screen time. It's important to take regular breaks, and experts recommend that gamers don't have more than two hours of screen time in a day. Remember, this includes TV and tablet screen time, as well as video games!
