<b>AQUEDUCT</b>	People who came from Africa
<b>BARBARIAN</b>	Bridge used to carry water to a city or town
<b>CARTHAGINIAN</b>	Person who originally lived outside the Roman Empire
<b>CELTIBERIAN</b>	Piece of metal used as money
<b>CIVILISATION</b>	People who lived in the Iberian Peninsula
<b>COIN</b>	Society with advanced social development, organization and culture
<b>COLONY</b>	Win a war or battle
<b>CONQUEST</b>	Area controlled by a foreign country or civilisation
<b>DEFEAT</b>	Taking control of a country using military force
<b>EMPEROR</b>	Ruler of an empire
<b>EMPIRE</b>	Attack a country or place
<b>HISPANIA</b>	Roman name for the Iberian Peninsula
<b>INVADE</b>	Large territory ruled by one person
<b>LAW</b>	System of rules that people must obey
<b>PHOENICIAN</b>	Ruins from an ancient civilisation
<b>REMAINS</b>	People who came from Asia
<b>ROMANISATION</b>	How the Romans changed the culture, economy and social organization of the peoples they conquered.
<b>SIEGE</b>	Person who is the property of another person
<b>SLAVE</b>	Enemy forces surround a city and stop water and food from entering it
