1- What are the types of stimuli?

They are external stimuli and internal stimuli.

External stimuli are changes that happen outside the body.

Internal stimuli are changes that happen inside the body

2- What are the types of response?

They are motor response or glandular response.

Motor response is when the brain orders the muscles to move.


Glandular response is the process in which organs, called glands, produce a substance.

3- What are the five senses?

We receive information from the environment and from our own body through our five senses: smell, taste, touch, sight and hearing.

4- What is the nervous system?

The nervous system is the control centre of our body. It sends, receives and interprets information: sense organs, sensory nerves, central nervous system, motor nerves and musculoskeletal system.
